he began studying the transverse flute with Maestro Fiorenzo Di Tommaso at the Liceo Musicale di Fermo directed by Prof. Annio Giostra. He graduated in Rome in 1978 with honors under the guidance of Maestro Angelo Persichilli. He subsequently perfected in flute with Conrad Klemm, Gustav Scheck and Peter Lukas Graf, in chamber music with Riccardo Brengola and Dino Ascioffa and in orchestral conducting with Lu Ja and Alun Francis. He was a flute professor in various Italian conservatories and he has held many master classes in Italy and abroad. He recorded for Bongiovanni in Bologna and made numerous recordings for Rai. Since 86 he has been 1st flute of the Rai National Symphony Orchestra. Over the years he has often collaborated with the more prestigious Italian orchestras including the "Scala" for more than 2 years from '97 to '99 and with the most famous conductors such as Bernstein, Giulini, Pretre, Muti, Mazeel, Temirkanov, De Burgos etc. He founded and directed various Festivals and Competitions including the "Giordaniello" of Fermo The "CupraMusicaFestival" and the International Competition for oboe "Giuseppe Tomassini of Petritoli. He is the artistic director of the Concerti delle Grazie in Monte San Martino.
