

Paolo Valeriani

completed his musical studies at the "G.B.Pergolesi" Conservatory of Fermo, obtaining the Gold Pagella of merit. He also studied at the Superior Conservatory of Music in Hamburg with M ° Holtzel and at the Norwegian Academy of Music under the guidance of Prof. Froydis Ree Wekre. He participated in the Masterclasses of the Masters D. Clevenger, R.Vlatkovic, A.Allegri , J.Williams, D. Stagni, B.Schneider, Froydis Ree Wekre.

In 2001 he won the competition for 1st horn in the "G.Verdi" Symphony Orchestra of Milan conducted by Maestro R.Chailly; role he held until 2003. In 2002 he was chosen by Maestro R. Muti to fill the role of 1st horn in the Cherubini Orchestra, role he held until 2004. From 2004 to 2007 he held the role of 3rd horn in the Orchestra Philharmonic Arturo Toscanini conducted by Maestro Lorin Maazel. From 2007 to 2015 he collaborated as 2nd horn in the Orchestra of the Teatro alla Scala and in the respective Philharmonic.

He has toured in: United States, France, Spain, Germany, Turkey, Russia, Morocco, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Venezuela, Thailand, Japan, China, Korea.

In 2007 he won the 3rd prize at the 'D. Ceccarossi' international competition in Orsogna.

In 2014 he was a finalist in the Competition for 2nd horn in the Orchestra of the Teatro alla Scala in Milan and in 2015 he was second qualified in the Competition for 2nd horn in the Musikkolegium Orchestra of Winterthur.

In 2016 he won the competition for 2nd horn in the RAI National Symphony Orchestra, a role he still holds today.

Since 2019 he is professor in the Horn class at the "G. Ghedini" Conservatory of Music in Cuneo.
